

FOR THE GRANT OF SHARE CONTRIBUTION TO THE SCHOOL/COLLEGE COOPERATIVE STORES

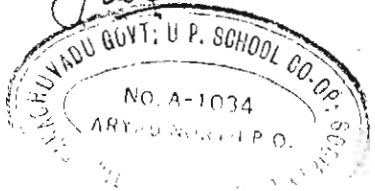
- 1. These Rules may be called the "Rules for the grant of share Capital contribution to School/College Cooperative Stores.
- 2. Financial Assistance by way of contribution to the Share Capital of School/College Cooperative Stores shall be made by the State Government to selected School/College Cooperative Stores.
- 3. The amount of assistance admissible to School/College stores shall be fixed as follows:-
 - a. Assistance will be provided by way of share capital contribution to serve as working capital and also to enhance the borrowing power of the stores.
 - b. School/college Cooperative stores selected by the Joint Registrar of Cooperative Societies for the purpose, shall be eligible for a share capital contribution upto 5 times of the paid up share capital collected from individual members subjects to a maximum of Rs.5,000/- for School Cooperative Stores and Rs.15,000/- for College Cooperative Stores.
- 4. The selection of stores eligible for the financial assistance shall be made by the Joint Registrar of Cooperative Societies of the District Concerned.
- 5. A School/College Cooperative Store to be eligible for share Capital Contribution shall satisfy the following conditions, namely.
 - a. The Store shall have adopted the bye-laws prescribed by the Registrar of Cooperative Societies. The bye-laws should have provision for Govt. participation in the share capital.
 - b. A School/College Cooperative stores shall have a minimum membership of 100 and paid up share capital of Rs.1000/- and shall have a minimum sales turnover of Rs.10,000/- per annum.
 - c. A College Cooperative Stores shall have a minimum membership of Rs.100 and paid up share capital of Rs. and shall have a minimum sales turnover of Rs. per annum.
- 6. A School/College Cooperative Stores obtaining assistance under these Rules shall maintain such records and books of accounts as the Registrar of Cooperative Societies may from time to time prescribed.




passed the Board of Directors agreeing to abide by these Rules and the instructions, the Registrar of Cooperative Societies may give from time to time.

- 8. The Joint Registrar of Cooperative Societies shall be competent to sanction Government contribution to the share capital of School/College Cooperative Stores.
- 9. The amount drawn from the Treasury shall be deposited in a separate interest bearing Bank Account in the name of the Society. The amount so deposited shall be withdrawn by the Stores only with the prior sanction of the Joint Registrar concerned.
- 10. The School/College Cooperative Stores shall forward to the Joint Registrar of Cooperative Societies concerned, a printed Share Certificate in favour of the Govt. of Kerala within one month of the enactment of the bill. An agreement in Form B appended to these Rules shall be executed by the Stores before the withdrawal of the amount.
- 11. The Government Contribution towards the Share Capital under these Rules shall be for a period of 15 years to be repaid into annual equal instalments, the first instalment commencing from the 6th anniversary of the drawal of the amount from time to time the Treasury.
- 12. Notwithstanding any thing contained in these Rules or in the bye-laws of the Stores, it shall be open to Registrar of Cooperative Societies of Government to withdraw at any time without assigning any reasons the whole or any portion of the Government Share, in which case the store shall be liable to refund to Government. The value of the share so withdrawn in lump.

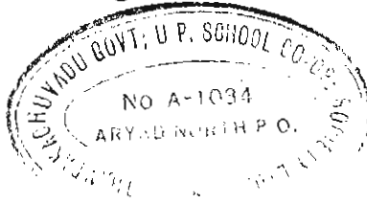

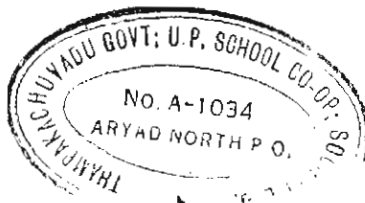
13. The dividend according to the share capital contribution by the Government shall be remitted to the Treasury within one month after the declaration of the dividend by the General body of the stores.
14. The Registrar of Cooperative Societies may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing exempt any school/College Cooperative stores from any one of the provisions contained in these Rules.

THIS AGREEMENT IS EXECUTED on this the Day of
..... between the Max
Govt. U.P. School, Thampakachuvadu Co-operative Society Ltd No.A-1034
Thampakachuvadu registered under the Kerala Co-operative Society Act
XXI of 1969 and having its registered office at Thampakachuvadu
(hereinafter referred to as "the Society") of the one part and the
Governor of Kerala (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") of
the other part.

WHEREAS the Society has applied to the Government for financial
assistance by way of share capital under the rules for the grant of
share capital contribution to the school/College Co-operative Stores
(hereinafter referred to as the "said Rules").

AND WHEREAS, the Government have agreed to the participation
in the Share capital of the Society subject to the terms and con-
dition contained in the said rules and these hereinafter appearing.

NOW OTHER PRESENTS WITNESS AND AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The amount of Rs. 5000/-..... (Rupees five thousand only)
advanced to the Society shall be utilised only for the purpose of
share capital of the Society and for no other purpose.
2. The Society shall abide by all the terms and conditions
contained in the said rules, a copy of which is herewith appended
which shall form part of this agreement as if incorporated herein.
3. In case the Society commit breach of all or any of the
terms and conditions herein contained or those contained in the
said rules, the entire amount advanced shall become repayable in
a lump at once and the Society shall pay the same.
4. All sums owed due to Government under or by virtue of this
agreement shall recoverable from the Society and its Assets, movable and
immovable under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act, for the time
being in force as though such sums are arrears of public Revenue due
on land or in such other manner as the Government may deem fit.

5. The Society agrees to deposit the whole amount of Rs. (Rupees) received by them as Share Capital contribution of the Government in a separate bank accounts specified by the Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Alappay. The amount so deposited shall be withdrawn by the Society only with the prior permission of the Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies.

6. The Society shall forward to the Joint Registrar of Co-operative Societies a printed share Certificate in favour of the Government of Kerala within one month from the date of the encashment of the amount of Government contribution towards the share capital.

7. The amount of Government Contribution towards the share Capital received by the Society shall be returned in 10 annual equal instalment of Rs. (Rupees) the first instalment shall be due on (H.E. the date) that is the 6th anniversary of the drawal of the amount by the Society and the subsequent instalments on the corresponding dates of the succeeding year.

8. The dividend accruing on the share-capital contribution by the Government shall be remitted by the Society in the Alappay Sub-Treasury within one month after the declaration of the dividend by the General body of the Society.

9. Notwithstanding anything thousand in this agreement or in the Rules, or in the order or in the Bye-laws of the Society, it shall be open to the Government or the Registrar of Co-operative Societies to withdraw at any time the whole or any portion of the Government-shares and in which case Society shall be liable to returned to Govt, the value of the shares withdrawn.
