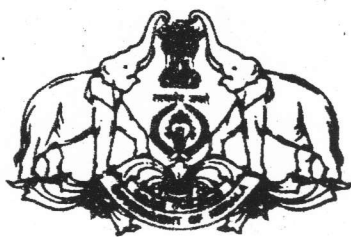

ORDER

G. O. (P) No. 171/2011/Co-op. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 1st December, 2011.

S. R. O. No. 770/2011.—WHEREAS, under the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, no employee of a society shall be promoted to the next higher post, if he has not successfully completed a short term training programme/course conducted by any of the institutions mentioned therein on the subject which is relevant to the objects/activities of the society in which he is employed;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Kerala as per order issued under G. O. (P) No. 21/2011/Co-op. dated 8th February, 2011 and published as S. R. O. No. 109/2011 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 285 dated 8th February, 2011 exempted all Co-operative Societies under the control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, registered or deemed to be registered

under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969) from the operation of the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the said Rules for a period of six months from 2nd November, 2010 and as per order issued under G. O. (P) No.130/2011/Co-op. dated 13th September, 2011 and published as S. R. O. No. 586/2011 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 1739 dated 23rd September, 2011 exempted all Co-operative Societies under the control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, registered or deemed to be registered under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969) from the operation of the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the said Rules for a further period of six months from 2nd May, 2011;

AND WHEREAS, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies has reported the fact that despite the granting of time for a further period of six months from 2nd May, 2011 for implementation of the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 for enabling the employees of Co-operative Institutions to undergo the Co-operative training on a phased manner due to the limitations in imparting training to large number of incumbents and due to the inability of various Co-operative institutions to depute many of its employees together for undergoing the training within the extended time limit also, resulting in preferring many petitions by various organizations of Co-operative employees before the Government for further extension of time;

AND WHEREAS, the Government are satisfied that a reasonable solution in this regard would be to exempt all Co-operative Societies under the control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies from the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 for a further period of six months from 2nd November, 2011;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by rule 181 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, the Government of Kerala hereby exempt all Co-operative Societies under the control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, registered or deemed to be registered under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969) from the operation of the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the said Rules for a further period of six months from 2nd November, 2011.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Rule 185 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 was amended by inserting fourth proviso to sub-rule (1), stipulating that no employee of a society shall be promoted to the next higher post, if he has not successfully completed a short term training programme/course conducted by the institutions mentioned therein as the subject which is relevant to the objects/activities of the society in which he is employed. Despite the granting of time for a further period of 6 months from 2nd May, 2011 for implementation of the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the said Rules for enabling the employees of Co-operative Institutions to undergo the Co-operative training in phased manner due to the limitations in imparting training to large number of incumbents and due to the inability of various Co-operative institutions to depute many of its employees together for undergoing the training within the extended time limit also, resulting in preferring many petitions by the various organization of Co-operative employees before the Government for further extension of time. The Government consider that a reasonable solution in this regard would be to exempt all Co-operative Societies from the fourth proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 and in the public interest have decided to exempt all Co-operative Societies under the control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies in the State from the fourth proviso to the sub-rule (1) of rule 185 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 for a further period of six months from 2nd November, 2011.

The order is intended to achieve the above object.
