G. O. (P) No. 7/2016/Co-op.

Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 14th January, 2016.

S. R. O. No. 86/2016.—WHEREAS, under clause (e) of Rule 46 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 a delegate of one society sitting on the committee of another society shall cease to be a member of such committee, if the society which sends him as delegate is in default to the society, in the Committee of which he sits as a delegate;

AND WHEREAS, Government have exempted the Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks in the State from the provision of clause (e) of rule 46 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 for a period of one year from 1st October, 2013 as per order issued under G. O. (P) No. 144/2013/Co-op. dated, 21st November, 2013 and published as S. R. O. No. 915/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 3277 dated, 21st November, 2013 and for a period of one year from 1st October, 2014 as per Order issued under G. O. (P) No. 134/2014/Co-op. dated, 4th November, 2014 and published as S. R. O. No. 677/2014 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 2658 dated 4th November, 2014;

AND WHEREAS, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies has requested Government to extend the exemption for a further period of one year from 1st October, 2015 as the circumstance which led to the issuance of the above said Orders are still in existence;

AND WHEREAS, Government have considered the matter in detail and are satisfied that the Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks in the State need to be exempted from the provisions of clause (e) of Rule 46 of the Kerala Co-operative societies Rules, 1969 for a further period of one year from 1st October, 2015;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by rule 181 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, Government of Kerala hereby exempt the Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks in the State from the provisions of clause (e) of rule 46 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969 for a further period of one year from 1st October, 2015.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

In consideration of the fact that the borrowers of Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks in the State were in default to the Banks due to the debt relief Schemes declared for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes categories, fishermen and in the applications pending before the Kerala Agricultural Debt Relief Commission. As a result, Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks in the state which had taken loan from the Kerala State Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Bank were unable to repay the loan within the repayment period. Government exempted the Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks from the provisions of clause (e) of rule 46 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, for a period of one year from 1st October, 2013 vide Government Order issued under G.O. (P) No. 144/13/Co-op. dated, 21-11-2013 and published as S. R. O. No. 915/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 3277 dated, 21st November, 2013 and for a period of one year from 1st October, 2014 vide Government order issued under G. O. (P) No. 134/2014/Co-op. dated, 4th November, 2014 and published as S. R. O. No. 677/2014 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 2658 dated 4th November, 2014. Since the situation which led to the issuance of the said order is still continuing, the Government have decided to exempt the Primary Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Banks from the provisions of clause (e) of Rule 46 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, for a further period of one year from 1st October, 2015.

The order is intended to achieve the above purpose.
