WHEREAS, sub-Section (4) of section 69 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969, [Act 21 of 1969] provides that all monetary disputes mentioned in Schedule III to the Act shall be filed within the time limit specified in the said Schedule;



AND WHEREAS, as per notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 136/2013/Co-op dated 30th October, 2013 and published as S.R.O No 875/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No 3138 dated 1st November, 2013 the Government of Kerala had exempted all Co-operative Societies from the provision of sub-section (4) of section 69 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969) for a period of one year with effect from 14th February, 2013 and as per notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 35/2015/Co-op dated 27th February, 2015 and published as SRO No. 112/2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extra ordinary No. 484 dated 6th March, 2015, exempted all Co-operative Societies for a further period of one year ten months and eighteen days from 14th February, 2014 to 31st December, 2015;

AND WHEREAS, the Registrar of Co-operative Societies has reported that the exemption granted was inadequate to comply with the statutory requirements and requested for further extension of the period of exemption;

AND WHEREAS, the Government have considered the matter in detail and are satisfied that it is necessary in public interest to extend the period of exemption granted to all Societies from the provisions of sub-section (4) of Section 69 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (Act 21 of 1969), for a further period of four years and three months from 1st January, 2016 to 31st March, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 101 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969, the Government of Kerala hereby exempt all Co-operative Societies from the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 69 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (Act 21 of 1969), for a further period of four years and three months from 1st January, 2016 to 31st March, 2020.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

Sub-Section (4) of section 69 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 provides that all monetary disputes mentioned in Schedule III to the Act shall be filed within the time limit specified in the said Schedule. The Government of Kerala as per notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 136/2013/Co-op dated 30th October, 2013 and published as S.R.O No. 875/2013 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 3138 dated 1st November, 2013 exempted all Co-operative Societies from the provision of sub-section (4) of section 69 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969) for a period of one year with effect from 14th February, 2013 and as per notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 35/2015/Co-op dated 27th February, 2015 and published as S.R.O No. 112/2015 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No. 484 dated 6th March, 2015 granted exemption for a further period of one year ten months and eighteen days from 14th February, 2014 to 31st December, 2015. The Registrar of Co-operative Societies has now reported that the exemption granted was inadequate to comply with the statutory requirements and requested for further extension of the period of exemption. The Government have considered the matter in detail and are satisfied that it is necessary in public interest to extend the period of exemption granted to all Societies from the provisions of sub-section (4) of Section 69 of The Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (Act 21 of 1969), for a further period of four years and three months from 1st January, 2016 to 31st March, 2020.
