In exercise of the powers conferred by section 109 of the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (21 of 1969), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, the same having been previously published under Notification



No.Co-op.B1/8/2020/Co-op dated 17th March, 2020 in the Kerala Gazette Extra Ordinary No. 1021 dated 1st April, 2020 as required by sub-section (1) of section 109 of the said Act namely:-

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Kerala Co-operative Societies (II Amendment) Rules, 2020.
(2) They shall come into force at once.
2. *Amendment of the Rules.*— In the Kerala Co-operative Societies Rules, 1969, after sub rule (2) of rule 183, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

“ Provided that part-time contingent employees shall be eligible to continue in the service of a society up to the last day of the month in which he/she attains the age of 70 years”.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (2) of rule 183 of the Kerala Co-Operative Societies Rules 1969, no employee shall be eligible to continue in the service of a



society after the last day of the month in which he attains the age of 58 years. The retirement age of part time contingent employees of Government sector is 70 years. The difference in retirement age of part time contingent employees in Government sector and that of Co-operative Societies/Banks is against the declared norms of the Government. Hence the Government have decided to raise the retirement age of the part time contingent employees in Co-operative Societies/Banks up to the last day of the month in which he/she attains the age of 70 years. The draft rules were previously published as required under sub-section 109 of Kerala Co-operative Societies Act, 1969 (Act 21 of 1969) as per notification No.Co-op/B1/8/2020/Co-op dated 17th March, 2020 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.1021 dated 1st April 2020 inviting suggestions or objections, if any in respect of the said Draft Rules. No objection/suggestion was received from any person with in the time limit specified. Hence the Government have accepted the amendment.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
